

# Sample Coast Guard Rating Exhibit

**ID Number.** An eight- or nine-character code assigned by ACE to identify each rate or rating exhibit.

**Title.** The official Coast Guard title of the general rate or rating during the period of the exhibit dates.

**Rating Designation.** The official Coast Guard system of identifying occupations and their levels; listed in ascending order according to rate.

**Exhibit Dates:** 10/94-12/98.

**Exhibit Dates.** Start and end dates by month and year. An end date of "Present" indicates that the general rate or rating still exists. "Pending Evaluation" means that the general rate or rating is scheduled to be evaluated.

**Occupational Group.** Number and title designating a group of related ratings.

**Occupational Group:** V (Aviation).

## Career Pattern

**SN:** Seaman (E-3). **AD3:** Aviation Machinist's Mate, Third Class (E-4). **AD2:** Aviation Machinist's Mate, Second Class (E-5). **AD1:** Aviation Machinist's Mate, First Class (E-6). **ADC:** Chief Aviation Machinist's Mate (E-7). **ADCS:** Senior Chief Aviation Machinist's Mate (E-8). **ADCM:** Master Chief Aviation Machinist's Mate (E-9).

**Career Pattern.** Path of advancement. Shows prerequisite general rate and subsequent progression in a rating; the designation is provided for each rate, followed by the title and paygrade (in parentheses).

**Description.** A summary description applying to all rates, and a separate description of the skills, competencies, and knowledge required for proficiency in each rate.

**Summary:** Services and maintains aircraft engines and .... **AD3:** Uses drawings, diagrams, blueprints .... **AD2:** Able to perform the duties required for AD3; performs aircraft preflight.... **AD1:** Able to perform the duties required for AD2; supervises aircraft ground handling.... **ADC:** Able to perform the duties required for AD1; serves as shop supervisor.... **ADCS:** Able to perform the duties required for ADC; serves as enlisted technical or specialty.... **ADCM:** Able to perform the duties required for ADCS; serves as senior enlisted ....

**Recommendation.** By rate. Only the recommendation for the *highest* rate held should be used; the recommendations should *not* be added. Educational credit is expressed in semester hours and recommended in four categories: vocational certificate, lower-division baccalaureate/associate degree, upper-division baccalaureate, and graduate degree.

## Recommendation, ADCM

**Team Review Date.** Date when the rate/rating was last evaluated by a team of faculty members drawn from academia. This information is particularly useful in subject areas where state-of-the-art is important in determining the applicability of credit. ACE's policy is that Team Reviews must occur at least every ten years.

**Review Date.** Most recent date the rate/rating was reviewed, either by an academic team or in-house by ACE (in-house reviews are conducted when changes to rate/rating content are minor).
